

BURNING PERMIT GENERAL GUIDELINES

Remember, you are legally responsible for any fire you start!

The Township office must issue a Burning Permit before any open burning may occur. Please call 662-2675 Monday through Friday 8:30 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. between Memorial Day and Labor Day Monday through Thursday 8:30 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. and Friday 8:30 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.

- ✓ A person requesting a burning permit must obtain a copy of these guidelines before any open burning occurs.
- ✓ **Brush** is the **only** material that may be burned.
- ✓ Open burning is allowed between sunrise and 9:00 p.m. **only**.
- ✓ A competent person must attend all open burning at **all** times.
- ✓ Open burning must occur at least **100 feet from all property lines**.
- ✓ Open burning must occur at least **150 feet from any building you do not own**.
- ✓ All open burning must be fully extinguished and emitting no smoke after 9:00 p.m.
- ✓ No burning is permitted at any time or in any location which would be a **nuisance or hazard** to adjoining persons or property by reason of **heat, flame, fly-ash, sparks, smoke or odor**.
- ✓ Violation of the Burning Ordinance is a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of up to \$500 and/or up to 90 days in the county jail. In addition, any person that sets an open fire that necessitates calling the Auburn/Williams Fire Department, or any other fire department, shall reimburse Williams Township for all costs and expenses incurred pursuant to the current Williams Township Emergency Response Cost Recovery Ordinance.
