May 27, 2014

1. Call to Order and Roll Call  
The meeting was called to order by Chairman, Jim Plant at 7:00 P.M. in the Township Board room. Committee Members present: Bill Warren, Scott Heinz, Kyle Plant, Dave Caylor, and Jim Plant.
2. Pledge of Allegiance  
The Pledge of Allegiance to the flag of the United States was said in unison.

5. Review of Minutes  
Meeting Minutes from the Monthly meeting on January 15, 2014 were presented and reviewed. W. Warren made a motion to accept the Minutes as presented. The motion was supported by Kyle plant, and passed unanimously. Dave Caylor was reluctant to cast a vote on a meeting that he did not attend.
6. Title search on Pipeline Property  
Plant reported that the Pipeline title search has been completed by First American title. Total cost of the search was significantly lower than quoted. The final outcome of the ownership was that Breitburn Operating L.P. from California is the owner of the property. This information was given to Jeff Martin V.P. Dow Chemical at a meeting held with Bay regional Alliance on April 18, 2014. A meeting will be held with Breitburn to discuss use of their property for a Pathway connector between Bay City and Midland.
7. Non – Motorized Transportation Subcommittee  
Plant reported that he had recently attended the first meeting of the Midland NMT committee in April to discuss plans to develop a Non-Motorized Transportation plan in the community that would be a first step for state and local funding of trails. Williams Township is under the jurisdiction of Midland for this project. Members from Midland City, Midland County, and M-Dot were present at this meeting.
8. Garfield and Midland road Pedestrian Signal  
Plant informed the group that efforts are underway to place a crosswalk signal on the Garfield - Midland road crossing. Funding for this project is being sought by the local government and community. Betty Owen is coordinating this project.
9. Sidewalk Update  
Plant informed the group that at the May meeting of the Township Board that funding for completion of a 5 foot sidewalk on the north side of Midland Road was approved from the Fire Station West to Meadow Court. Surveying would begin soon with a July - August start date. Completion of a sidewalk back to the Township Park is also included in this project.
