Lawrence-Webster <input type="radio"/> PROPOSAL 08-2 A PROPOSAL TO AMEND THE STATE CONSTITUTION TO ADDRESS HUMAN EMBRYO AND HUMAN EMBRYONIC STEM CELL RESEARCH IN MICHIGAN The proposed constitutional amendment would: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Expand use of human embryos for any research permitted under federal law subject to the following limits: the embryos-- <ul style="list-style-type: none"> --are created for fertility treatment purposes; --are not suitable for implantation or are in excess of clinical needs; --would be discarded unless used for research; --were donated by the person seeking fertility treatment. · Provide that stem cells cannot be taken from human embryos more than 14 days after cell division begins. · Prohibit any person from selling or purchasing human embryos for stem cell research. · Prohibit state and local laws that prevent, restrict or discourage stem cell research, future therapies and cures. | COUNTY | | Basic Health Services Millage Proposal Shall the limitation of the amount of property taxes which may be assessed each year against all taxable real and personal property in Bay County be increased by not more than .67 mill (67¢ per \$1,000 of taxable valuation) as new additional millage for a period of 8 years, 2008 through 2015, inclusive, or until altered by the voters of the County, to provide funds to be used by the County for a basic health services delivery system for the prevention and treatment of health problems of uninsured and underinsured residents of the County?
